Dear Members of St. George's Parish,

Greetings as Lenten Season is upon us!

As **Social Justice** member of our parish council, and the **Development and Peace** representative, I'd like to make you aware of a few things.

\*FALL CAMPAIGN: In the fall **D & P** had an educational campaign to help make us aware of this year's emphasis - "People & Planet First". **D & P** hopes to make us all aware that many people in the Global South struggle constantly, with large companies to preserve their rivers, forests, wildlife and plants.

Aside from this awareness, **Development & Peace** has petitioned the government to implement "*due diligence laws*" requiring Canadian companies in the Global South, to respect human and environmental rights in their overseas operations.

\*LENTEN CAMPAIGN: We are now heading into the **Lenten Campaign for D & P**, continuing with the theme of "People & Planet First". The Lenten campaign is their *fundraising one*. *Development & Peace, in conjunction with Caritas Canada* are asking, as part of your Lenten Almsgiving, that you consider donating to this cause. **D & P and Caritas Canada** work in many underdeveloped countries in our world, but this year they have an emphasis on three countries: **Cambodia, Honduras, and Madagascar**. Some of the projects include things like working with people of the villages developing things they request, like help with Eco -conversion: stoves, solar panels and vegetable gardens. there's lots more info about these projects on the website.

There are *several* ways that you can give to this worthy cause.

- 1) Church collection envelopes - April 3rd there is a designated envelope.
- 2) Put an envelope into the collection at Mass anytime. Be sure to label it Development & Peace and include your name.
- 3) Sign up to be a **Year Round Donor**. More information on this to follow.

\* HELP FOR THE UKRAINE: At this time we are all upset and worried for the people of the Ukraine! We feel helpless! There are a few things we CAN do.

- First of all **PRAY**. Pray for the people of the Ukraine, and that the leaders of the Russian people will find a way back to peace!

- Secondly, we can donate to Emergency Humanitarian Aid to the people of the Ukraine through Development & Peace.
