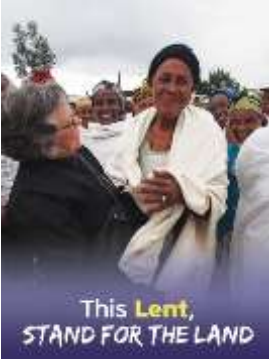
### Things to Remember During Our Lenten Journey

### Development and Peace: a movement of solidarity



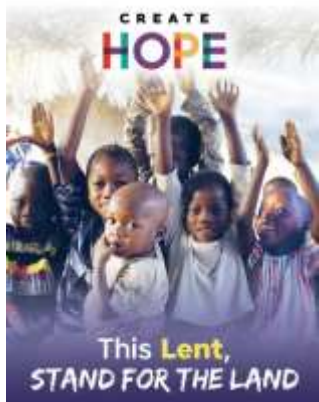
Established in 1967, Development and Peace — Caritas Canada is the official international solidarity organization of the Catholic Church in Canada.

### Colombia: defence of land and territory

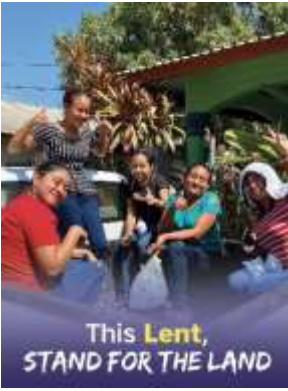


Colombia is home to nearly 10 per cent of the planet's biodiversity, yet it is also one of the most dangerous countries for people defending their land and territory against exploitation.
