Something else of urgent concern!!!

In December of 2024, Finance Minister Chrystia Freeland put forth a *recommendation* that the Income Tax Act be amended to disallow income tax deductions for advancement of religion. This has not become a bill, but it is important that we express our concern BEFORE it comes before the House of Commons.
