

- ⇒ The gospel passage for this Sunday is rather short. However, it speaks something of what kind of Shepherd Jesus is, and what are or should be the qualities of the people, being the sheep that Jesus cares for. This is why this Sunday is also known as the Good Shepherd Sunday.
- ⇒ Jesus the Good Shepherd gives life to his sheep. He says: "I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish." Such is the goodness and the greatness of the shepherding of Jesus. He is a giver of life, and not just an ordinary life, but an eternal life. Jesus does not appear to us only as Saviour and Lord. Rather, he is also the Good Shepherd. As such, his vision for us is to give us life, to give us eternal life.
- ⇒ Human shepherds have the same vision. It is a characteristic of a shepherd to take care of the life of the sheep. In fact, shepherds always protect the lives of the sheep, protect them from every danger. Thus, they give life to the sheep.
- The bishops and priests are also called to be shepherds of the people, following Jesus the Good Shepherd. Most of the time, these shepherds speak before the people. They may speak something that is not nice, something that shakes us. They speak something against the controversial issues that are discussed in our society. And often, we do not care. Why? Because we are not comfortable with these issues. We cannot accept what they say. But the challenge is to put these issues in the context of the shepherding of Jesus. If we want life or eternal life, then we should listen to our shepherds.

We are pleased to invite you all to a Eucharistic Celebration wherein our seminarian, <u>Arpee Urguico</u>, will publicly manifest his will to offer himself to God and to the Church, so that he may exercise a sacred order. This is the third out of five steps towards priesthood (Lector, Acolyte, Candidacy, Diaconate, and Priesthood). <u>The ceremony will take place within the 11:00 AM Mass on Sunday, April 3rd, 2016 at St.George's Parish, Assiniboia, SK.</u> (Archbishop Weisgerber will preside the Mass.) ⇒ POTLUCK BRUNCH after Mass.
