On April 30, 2000, as he canonized Blessed Faustina, John Paul II named the Second Sunday of Easter as "Divine Mercy Sunday." The Pope explained that this day is "the Sunday of Thanksgiving for all goodness that God has shown us in the whole of the Easter mystery."
