REFLECTION : HOMECOMING :

The two disciples on the road to Emmaus head for home to forget their experience of loss, pain, betrayal, murder, and politics that have taken place in Jerusalem. They make no headway at all until a stranger joins them. Unrecognized, the risen Jesus leads the disciples to understand the mystery behind the events they have witnessed.

The disciples invite the stranger to stay. And Jesus celebrates the ritual of the Passover once again with them - He takes bread, says the blessing, breaks it, and gives it to them. Their journey is thus completed by the presence of Jesus. Their hearts are burning, and their faith has been rekindled.

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, look kindly on those who have left you behind for dead in some unmarked tomb. Come to them, as you did to the disciples on the road to Emmaus. Explain to them the scriptures again. Stir up in them the fires of faith that still smoulder in their hearts. Sit down with them at the table. Show yourself to them again, in the midst of your church, in the breaking of the bread.
