St Louis Parish in Mossbank invites everyone to join us for the Feast of St Louis celebration, Aug 25th at 4:00 pm. Outdoor mass on the church grounds followed by an old fashion potluck picnic and time of fellowship. Bring your lawn chairs and picnic baskets. We look forward to sharing the day with you! Saint Louis was born Louis Capet April 25, 1214 in France. He was the oldest son of King Louis the 8th and Blanche of Castile. He was 11 years old when his father died after only 3 years as King of France. His mother was declared regent for her son until he reached the age of 22. He reigned for 44 years. He is famous for promoting Christianity in France, establishing religious foundations, collecting religious relics and building leper hospitals. He was married at the age of 19 and had 11 children-this family blood line maintained power in France for 500 years. He died August 25, 1270 while in Algeria on a crusade. He was canonized 27 years after his death. St Louis is the patron saint of masons and sculptors.
