The Advent wreath dates back to ancient celebrations of the winter solstice—that time in the year when the sun reaches its south. ern-most point in the heavens and the days are the darkest and most gloomy. Because they longed for the return of the sun's light and life, the ancients stopped all usual activity, sacrificed the use of their wagon wheels and hung them up, festooned with lights and greens in their celebration halls.

There they awaited the return of their sun-god, thinking of the warmth and life he brought. Celebrations culminated in the "nativity" of the sun - the turning

point of the year.

As Christians, we use the same meaningthis custom to anticipate the feast of light and life: the nativity of the Savior We add one light on the wreath for each Sunday in Advent. We think of the darkness after Adam's sin and watch the growing hope and light as the prophets and the Virgin help us prepare saving birth.
