# Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Jospel

## Repent, and believe in the Gospel.

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. Ashes are used as a sign of our sorrow for having turned away from God; they are placed on our forehead in the sign of the cross and we wear them until they wear off. The ashes are often produced by burning palms from the previous year's Passion Sunday celebration.
