⇒ Consider this. Recently the 70th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz was observed. We shudder at how many people were killed there. But how do we feel about all the lives lost to abortion and might be lost to euthanasia if this is allowed. Our spring banquet on May 3 will focus on euthanasia. The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition is alerting us that the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and Saskatchewan has adopted, in principle, a policy that would force physicians to take part in (referrals) euthanasia. This would, in fact, go against their Policy of Conscientious Refusal, which states that they do have the right of conscientious refusal. The College of Physicians and Surgeons is seeking feedback on The Policy—Conscientious Refusal, before March 6, 2015. Please write to the College:

- Ask them to uphold their promise of "Do no harm"
- Insist that physicians must maintain their right of conscience to refuse to participate
- Tell them that you would not feel safe if your physician participates in euthanasia or assisted suicide

She was declared a Saint in 2000. On February 8, Catholics all over the world are encouraged to host or attend prayer services to create greater awareness about this phenomenon. Through prayer, we not only reflect on the experiences of those that have suffered through this affront to human dignity, but also comfort, strengthen, and help empower survivors.
