



Seek The Lord

Youth is the time of new adventures and new experiences. Many youth simply jump from living experience to experience without direction. Others spend their youth seeking, trying to find the answer to Life and Truth. Some just look for the next convenience. Others seek something worth their Lord. commitment.

To end the Christmas season, we turn to the Gospel of Matthew's story of the Magi, the wise men who rose above the mundane day-to-day experience to seek someone. The "light to the nations," the newborn King of the Jews.

The feast of Epiphany celebrates the revelation of Christ to the pagan nations. And it points to Israel's place as the source of God's revelation.
