In December of 2009 Archbishop Daniel Bohan formed a Property Committee of eight members from our Catholic Community. The committee investigated all options and uses for the John Paul II Property at 2200 – 25th Ave., Regina, Sask., directly east of LeBoldus High School. This does not include the Sisters of the Precious Blood Monastery located at the back. The committee has recommended the Archdiocese sell, lease or develop the property. The committee will provide further reports as their work continues.

IRAQI FAMILY UPDATE

First I would like to wish you all the best in 2012 and a very blessed New Year. Our Iraqi Refugee family arrived in Regina on December 20th. and I was privileged to meet them. They were very quiet and could speak very little English but there were smiles all around. Let me introduce you to the family:

Father	Ghiyath Hirmiz	35 years old
Mother	Nora Gourges	32 years
Daughter	Rita Sabah	15 years
Son	Romel Sabah	12 years
Daughter	Rosealinda Sabah	8 years
Son	Remsen Hirmiz	2 years

They are a very young Catholic family and very appreciative of everything we have done for them. The father is a Chef who has worked in 5-star restaurants so that is very good. The family speaks and writes a bit of English and that is somewhat good for school and employment but there is a long way to go to build their English to be job-ready. I am a teacher and hope to tutor them in English if that is alright. According to our contract with Immigration and Sponsorship, we must support the family for a full year or until the family is fully supporting itself. Rent is 1500.00 per month and then there are telephone, food, groceries, supplies, clothes and other incidentals per month for a family of 6 which is not cheap. We still need financial help to support this family and the second family we hope to sponsor in the near future. Any help that you or your church can supply or raise for this family and our second Iraqi family would be most graciously appreciated.
