Today's gospel preserves the last spoken words of Mary that we find in the New Testament.

After today's gospel we never hear Mary quoted again. Of course, she said other things, but the gospel does not record them for us.

What are the last spoken words of Mary that we find in today's gospel?

They are just five words. Mary says, "Do whatever [Jesus] tells you."

Mary spoke these words to the waiters when the wine ran out.

But they are also directed, in a true sense, to every Christian who ever lived or will live:

"Do whatever [Jesus] tells you."

Mary's words contain the same important message that God the

Father spoke to Peter, James, and John when they were praying on the

mountain with Jesus. Luke describes the episode this way : "[Jesus] took

Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While He was

praying his face changed in

appearance and His clothing became dazzling white .... Then from the cloud

came a voice that said, 'This is my chosen Son; listen to Him.' "

Luke 9:28-29,35

"Listen to Him" - that is, "Do whatever He tells you."
