Two points about Pentecost have to be underscored.

First, Pentecost was a major Jewish feast - a thanksgiving celebration - combining gratitude for the year's harvest with gratitude for the Sinai covenant.

Meaning "50th," Pentecost occurred 50 days after Passover.

This explains why Jews from all over had gathered in Jerusalem. They were celebrating this great Jewish feast.

This also explains why Jews speaking many different languages were gathered together at one time.

Second, Pentecost must be seen against the background of the Tower of Babel story in the Old Testament.

Prior to the building of the tower, all the people spoke the same language. (Genesis 11:1) But when pride began to take

hold of the people and they began to build the tower, God "confused the speech of all the world" and "scattered them all over the earth." (Genesis 11:9)

The coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost reversed this situation. After the Holy Spirit's coming, the people of different languages in Jerusalem understood what the disciples were saying.

The point is clear.

What sin had split apart is now united by the Holy Spirit. God was re-creating the world and making it new again.

PRAYER:

Come, Holy Spirit, come !

Come as fire to warm us.

Come as wind to cleanse us.

Come as light to guide us.

Come as power to enable us.

Come, Holy Spirit, come !

Help us to renew the face of the earth !
