

Experiencing the Year of Mercy Living out the Year of Mercy

- ⇒ Last week we were told that the Year of Mercy is an invitation to love, kindness, and unbounding generosity. It is an opportunity for us to encounter God through the mercy of others. Now the big question is how can we give an opportunity to others to experience the incredible mercy of God? We can provide this opportunity to others by living out the Year of Mercy in our daily lives.
- ⇒ Pope Francis, in his Misericordiae Vultus, reminds us that the very foundation of the Church life is mercy. All the Church's pastoral activities should be caught up in the tenderness that she makes present to her believers; nothing in her preaching and in her witness to the world can be lacking in mercy. Her very credibility is seen in how she shows merciful and compassionate love. As members of the Body of Christ, our lives should reflect this witness of mercy to the people we meet every day. There is a need for the Church and all her members to live out the loving mercy that God has for us and our response to this loving mercy is for us to act in that same way to all those we meet.

The Holy Doors of Mercy

- ⇒The Jubilee year of Mercy commenced when Pope Francis opened the Holy Doors of St. Peter's Basilica last December 8th, 2015 and on December 13, 2015 all the Holy Doors in local Cathedrals and designated churches throughout the world opened to pilgrims.
- ⇒ Holy Doors of Mercy are one of the central components of the Jubilee year and they will be opened during this year of Mercy. Pope Francis in his, Bull of Indiction, said that the Holy Door will become a Door of Mercy through which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope.
- Since each diocese will have the opportunity to open a Door of Mercy in their diocese, we are blessed since we can have the opportunity to make a pilgrimage to our local Holy Door during this Jubilee. We are even too blessed since we have two Holy Doors in our diocese, the Holy Rosary Cathedral in Regina and the cocathedral at Our Lady of Assumption, Gravelbourg which is so close from our parish. During this Jubilee, Pope Francis encourages us to do a pilgrimage on these Holy Doors. The Pope said that this pilgrimage is to be a journey of walking closer with God and discovering moments of grace and spiritual renewal. The Doors are symbols of God's mercy, open to welcome everyone into the compassion of God's love.
