# Good News!

**March 2, 2014**

**EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)**

Is 49:14–15 / 1 Cor 4:1–5 / Mt 6:24–34

“Jesus loves me, this I know.”

We nod our heads when asked whether God loves us, but what would you say if you were asked, “Does God like you?”

God’s love is often difficult to fathom. Some of us are rational: “God loves everyone”—the unspoken thought being, “It’s his job to love me.” We say this about parents as well: “She’s my mom, she has to say that.” This idea of God’s love never moves further than the head.

Other people compartmentalize the love: “God loves me, but only when I’m good” or “God loves only the good parts of me.” Still others use God’s love as a shield against responsibility: “God forgives me no matter what I do and would never judge me harshly.” God becomes a marshmallow—all sugar, no nutrition.

In reality, God’s love holds us in delight as parents delight in their children. God’s love rejoices in us as the Creator rejoices in endless variety and hidden mystery.

God’s love doesn’t come out of necessity. Rather, it springs out of the nature of God. Out of love, God holds us accountable for our actions, forgives us when we ask, and is an abiding presence whether we recognize it or not. When we turn away, God is there. When we suffer, God walks with us. When we sin, God is the source of our conversion.

God grounds us in peace and joy. God doesn’t love us because we are the greatest and best—in that case, none of us would be worthy. God simply loves.

We have only to seek his righteousness to know that and believe it.
