Development and Peace is hoping to raise \$10 million in its new fundraising campaign that began on Ash Wednesday. This campaign shows how the organization's partners, in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Middle East are working to build a more just world. As a result of donations from the public, Development and Peace will be able to continue to work closely with well-established partners in the Global South, setting up programs that enable poor communities to ensure their own development. The organization also carries out educational and awareness-raising campaigns on international issues.

Regular updates on the situation are arriving from Caritas Internationalis and messages of compassion have gone out from the entire Caritas network to Caritas Japan as it responds to this tragedy.

Although Japan has the capacity to respond to the current emergency situation, Caritas Japan estimates that once the emergency phase is over, the most vulnerable will require support in regaining their lives and homes. It plans to organize reconstruction programs in the coming months to bring effective aid.
