### Easter Sunday, March 27:

⇒ Entering Jerusalem, Jesus presents Himself as the Messiah through signs that fulfill prophetic words. Zechariah prophesied a Messianic king who would enter Jerusalem triumphant, victorious, but humble (Zec 9:9). These qualities are embodied in the first sign: the animal, a lowly ass (donkey), on which the king sits. The king of peace triumphs not by arms or violence but with humility and meekness. In an earlier era, the

donkey was ridden by the nobility, but the Israelite monarchy set it aside for a horse.

⇒ Jesus now permits the people to acclaim Him as He enters Jerusalem alerts us to the second sign: Hosanna. This word, originally used to ask for help or salvation, forms part of the Hallel Psalms that are praises to God. In shouting Hosanna, people praise God because of Jesus and ask that they be saved!

⇒ This is linked to the third sign: the Son of David. Jesus, who refers to himself as the Son of Man, now lets himself be addressed as the Son of David, thereby admitting implicitly that he is the Messiah, who has been foretold to be a descendant of King David.

The second and third signs are linked to a fourth one: Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! This is another acclamation, expressing jubilation and gratitude for the person and presence of someone with a divine mission. One of the things that unfolds during the Holy Week is that, we the faithful are invited to look deep into our minds and hearts. How can we make our week truly "holy" and beneficial for our souls?
