Embroidery floss - any colour

# Good News

May 5, 2013 SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 / Rv 21:10-14, 22-23 / Jn 14:23-29

Some experiences you can have only when living with someone. You have a regular dinner companion, someone to share household responsibilities with, someone to share your day's experiences with. No matter what the relationship, it can be fantastic.

But sometimes it's not. Your parent snores loudly enough to wake the neighbors. Your roommate prefers the floor for clothes storage as opposed to a closet. Your spouse can't write "laundry detergent" or "olive oil" on the welldisplayed grocery list (not that my husband is guilty of any of these ... ).

That's why I did a double-take when reading today's Gospel. Jesus, in his farewell discourse from John, declares that he and the Father will "make our dwelling" with those who keep God's word. The Greek word for "dwelling" is mone. It indicates that this is not temporary—it's not an overnight camping trip or a two-week can-l-crash-on-yourcouch situation. Monë intends a permanent home for God with us-not over us or next to us or down the street. With us, within our very selves.

But hasn't God learned about roommates? Doesn't God know about the snoring? about our sins and our brokenness? our unworthiness and our doubts?

I certainly can't explain God's choices. I can only rejoice that God has decided to dwell with us in spite of our many flaws, foibles, quirks, and outright sin.

It's the best experience of "living with someone" I can imagine.
