Starting 13 May 1917 and for six consecutive months, the Blessed Mother Mary appeared to three children who shepherded their flock at Cova da Iria, Fatima, Portugal. On 13 October 1917, the Blessed Mother made her final appearance marked by a ten-minute spectacle of a spinning sun. The Blessed Mother's appearance carried the invitation to live heroic lives according to the Gospel of Jesus, her son. She called for:

(a) lives lived in conversion; (b) faithfulness to prayers, especially meditations on the Gospel mysteries of Jesus and Mary through the Rosary; (c) a sense of collective responsibility, and the practice of reparation for sins. The acceptance of the message of the Blessed Mother is to be signified by the Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, itself a symbol of commitment to faithfulness and to the apostolate. Neglect of conversion and of a life of faith was lamented by the Blessed Mother as a road to affliction and difficulties.
