Good News!

Ascension of the Lord / Seventh Sunday of Easter

Acts 1:1-11 / Eph 1:17-23 or 4:1-13 or 4:1-7, 11-13 / Mk 16:15-20

It's intriguing what qualifies as power in our world. As I write this, debates are ongoing about the right to carry concealed weapons. Whether such a right keeps people safer is in question, but certainly it makes people feel more powerful. The 2012 presidential campaign is in full swing, months before anyone casts a vote. Our democratic process is marvelous, but the campaign to determine who gets presidential power is, sadly, a messy and undignified process. And my husband and I are currently overwhelmed by the power of nature as water seeps (and sometimes pours) into our home. We thought our house was as powerful as Noah's ark, but it's proving far less mighty.

We certainly have the ability to wield power, but we often forget that ultimate power belongs to God. Our Ascension readings remind us that no human power can compare with "the surpassing greatness of his power for us who believe" (Ephesians 1:19). As if Jesus' incarnation and his resurrection weren't enough of a display of God's power, now Jesus ascends to heaven to his glorified place with the Father. God's mighty actions make our guns, authority figures, and defenses seem weak by comparison.

Perhaps we forget God's great power because it's not as visible as our human displays of power. Yet God continues to work mighty deeds—we know of amazing miracles that can be ascribed only to God's power. But also, God's power works in us—the Church. We have to be open enough to let God work through us, and that can be a challenge.

But Jesus promised to be with us always. If we trust in his very real power moving through us, we'll be amazed at what can be accomplished in our friendships, families, neighborhoods—even in our world.
