

Rohingya Refugee Crisis

More than 1.2 million Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh are completely destitute and living in abject poverty. They urgently need food, water and other basic necessities.

On August 25th, 2017, violence erupted between the Arakan Rohingya Salvation Army (ARSA) and the Myanmar Army in Rakhine State, a northern region of Myanmar prone to conflict.
