#### ANNUAL APPEAL BULLETIN REFLECTION:

"Amen, I say to you; today you will be with me in Paradise." Are those not the words we all aspire to hear? Jesus reminds us throughout Holy Scripture that we must keep our Christian life focus on two points: Jesus himself, and that our lives lead to Eternity. It is these thrusts that should make us lead lives of gratitude and thanksgiving to God.

This Sunday is traditionally called Christ the King. Yes, we recognize Jesus' Kingship over all the earth and all its peoples, but the Gospel points to the part of His dominion that cannot be matched by anyone else: He rules over death as well as over life. St. Catherine of Siena once said, "All the way to heaven is heaven, because Jesus said, "I am the way."

As we prepare for Advent, which begins next weekend, and as we end our liturgical year this week, we need to dedicate ourselves anew to being good stewards of all that the Lord, Christ our King, has blessed us with and to share those gifts as God's children. We also join with the forgiven thief who was crucified next to Jesus and place our total trust in God. While we attempt to be disciples of the Lord, we need to share what we have – time, talents and treasure in every opportunity the Lord gives us, no matter how small our best effort.
