**Stop the Hunger Crisis**

**An estimated 18.4 million people are facing food insecurity and over one million children are suffering from acute malnutrition.** Erratic weather has caused the failure of crops resulting in catastrophic food shortages. Although there is food at the market, high prices have made it increasingly difficult for families to purchase food. Furthermore, political turmoil in Mali is exacerbating the situation by causing the displacement of hundreds of thousands of people.

The Government of Canada announced on Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, that it will match dollar for dollar donations made to registered Canadian charities between August 7<sup>th</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup> for the humanitarian crisis in the **Sahel region of West Africa.**

Development and Peace is eligible for this matching program. The Canadian Government will place a sum equivalent to contributions made by donors to Development and Peace in the **Sahel Crisis Matching Fund.** Money from this fund will then be allocated by the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) to established Canadian and international humanitarian organizations for humanitarian assistance efforts that benefit the people most affected by the crisis.

### Calling the Faithful to prayer for an end to Abortion

Excerpts from the Regina Archdiocesan Social Justice Blog written by Bert Pitzel, Social Justice Coordinator is calling the Faithful to prayer for an end to abortion: "Sept 21, 2012, the second hour of debate on Motion 312 will take place. The Motion asks that a committee of 12 Members of Parliament be struck to discuss, using the latest medical and scientific evidence, when human life begins. On Sept 26<sup>th</sup>, this Motion will be voted on in the House of Commons. "

Motion 312 is in response to a 400-year-old law which says that you will be recognized as human only after you have been born."

*"We pray that the Truth concerning the dignity of human life from conception to natural death prevail in the debate on Motion 312 on the Sept 21<sup>st</sup>, and that the hearts and minds of MPs be open so that the Committee of 12 MPs will be formed to examine the most fundamental question of our human existence."*

*And we pray that Mary, protector of the unborn, help us."*
